Looking for a life changing experience? We want to invite you to participate in or support the Ecuador Worthy Bathroom Program. This is a separate program collaboration of the JAX Church and HOPE *worldwide* Ecuador. JAX Church has served with HOPE Ecuador in August of 2024, 2025 & plan to again in 2026. In August 2024, volunteers from HOPE *worldwide* Ecuador, and the JAX Church, participated in the Worthy Bathroom Program in Cunuyacu, an indigenous community outside of Quito & Ambato, Ecuador. Collectively, they have constructed or completed 53 bathrooms and engaged with the indigenous families of the community. The need is to construct approximately 80+ more in the region.

Through the generous support of donations and fund raisers we have raised nearly \$25,000 to provide construction materials, scholarships, and other supplies for volunteers from Quito and the USA. \$350 builds a bathroom. Please contribute any amount which is tax deductible. If you cannot go but want to support, you can donate to HOPE *worldwide* JAX Chapter.

\$1,000 Registration fee includes housing, ground transportation, meals, etc. You are responsible for airfare & medical / travel insurance. Grants of \$300 are available to assist with your registration. Total cost is approximately \$2,000.
